

Prey-Predator Monitoring workshop at Panna Tiger Reserve, Madhya Pradesh

The Animal Ecology Division of State Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur and Panna Tiger Reserve has jointly organized a training workshop on prey and predator monitoring at Hinauta Training Centre of Panna Tiger Reserve on 14th and 15th December 2024. In total, 100 frontline forest officials and computer operators participated in this training workshop and learned techniques about carnivore sign survey, line transect, inserting data in m-stripe android application and field installation of camera traps. This training workshop was mentored by Mr Ravindra Mani Traipathi (Dy Director and HoD, SFRI), Mrs Anjana Suchirta Tirkey (FD, Panna Tiger Reserve) and Mr Mohit Sood (Dy Director, Panna Tiger Reserve).
